As Neubauer Fellowship alumni are promoted, they join Leaders of Leaders, designed to provide the tools needed to effectively supervise and develop principals, improve principal practice, and increase student outcomes. Fellowship alumni also serve as coaches to promising principals in our Performance Partners experience, where high-potential principals deepen the instructional skills necessary to coach teachers, resulting in improved teacher practice and student outcomes. We serve nearly 150 school and system leaders across the city who impact nearly 100,000 Philadelphia students every day. This critical mass of leaders has the power to dramatically change students' lives. The PHENND Fellow will support our programming and highlight effective practices to improve the retention and performance of Philadelphia's school and system leaders.

Member Duties : Philadelphia's principals and school system leaders change lives. In order to develop, engage and retain leaders, it is important that they feel valued. As a VISTA, you will ensure that program participants are heard, celebrated and represented. You will acknowledge school and system leaders by identifying, highlighting and sharing successes, promising practices and tools. You will build systems to track and share news articles spotlighting participants and their impact. You will craft participant bios and school profiles that highlight successes and are used in selection, coaching, school visits and fundraising. You will also will manage surveys to gain feedback and identify next steps for programming. You will participate in and gain exposure to programming and support effective program delivery by coordinating logistics, tracking attendance and addressing participant needs. You will also spend time in schools to understand urban education, on-the-ground needs and school leadership.
